- 3. 2024 Graduating High School Senior with an overall grade point average of at least 3.0 as documented by a transcript. Online self-printed transcript is acceptable.
- 4. Letter of acceptance from a technical school, college, or university.
- 5. In a 300-to-500-word essay, share how you will use your college experience and degree to change, rebuild and restore our communities?
- 6. Statement of commitment for you and/or your parents (guardians) to attend the banquet, to publicly accept the NCAWM Elouise Fuller Scholarship at the NCAWM Convention in Raleigh, NC on November 23.
- 7. Prepare to **electronically** submit a biography written in third person and a headshot picture to be used in the program to officially award the scholarship, to eloisefullerscholarship@gmail.com.
